A staged transformation path

Begin with diagnosis, focus on priority decisions and workflows, establish enabling foundations, scale proven use cases, and institutionalise learning. The Intelligence Maturity Model provides a common language for sequencing this journey.

Key recommendations

- Conduct a strategic intelligence diagnostic.
- Establish cross-functional governance and executive sponsorship.
- Develop a portfolio of high-value intelligence use cases.
- Measure decision quality, productivity, risk reduction, innovation, and realised value.
- Build repeatable systems for capability renewal and responsible scaling.

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
